Curriculum

Our curriculum strives to nurture each child's intellectual, social, emotional, physical and spiritual development. The core of our curriculum is guided by the national curriculum framework. However, we have enriched our curriculum sufficiently with content for addressing children's special interests and needs for preparing them to be world class citizens of the twenty first century.

We have developed the Pre-school curriculum based on their ability combining the essence of Montessori and Early Childhood Development approaches. The curriculum develops the Social and Emotional Skills, Language Skills, Mathematical and Logical Skills, Practical Life Skills, Work Habits, Creativity, and Motor Skills. The Pre-school curriculum also includes Visual and Performing Arts to teach them to live a vibrant and joyful life.

Primary School (Grade I to III) Curriculum is enriched with additional skills in all the areas including languages and life skills. At this level, we have included international languages and the basics of computing, performing arts and visual arts too. Curriculum at this level is designed for an integrated approach so that children could learn to connect their knowledge with different disciplines and with their lives as well. Abacus is introduced from Grade III to enhance their mathematical and logical skills.

Middle School (Grade IV to VI) and Senior School (Grade VII to X) Curriculum is complemented by additional skills in computer application, language arts and soft skills. At these levels, students are expected to master the skills in performing arts, visual arts, games, etc. through clubs and various curricular and co-curricular activities. We have international language up to Grade VIII and Abacus up to Grade VII integrated in the curriculum.



Teaching Learning

We make sure that whatever practice we do puts the child's learning in focus. We design activities in many constructive ways that the children are provided with ample opportunities to lead their teams, learn to value others' viewpoints, generate knowledge on the strength of their teams and prove their achievements through collaborative, co-operative, project-based and activity-based experiential learning approaches.

Research and Innovations

We make children independent and self-sustaining to deal with the challenges of the time through research, innovations and problem solving in real life. These activities give our students plentiful opportunities to work in harmony with their community and contribute to its betterment. School adopts micro-level research as curricular and co-curricular activities for testing hypotheses, exploring the subjects, and understanding nature and the communities. We also guide and inspire students for connecting their learning to innovations and creations that ultimately foster students' aptitude to transform their learning for life through these research activities.

Excursions and Educational Tours

We organize regular excursions, field trips and educational tours for intensive learning as per the demand of the contents. Students are guided to observe, explore, investigate, analyze and share their experiences through reports and presentations. This indeed testifies to the essence of our philosophy of learning through real life experiences.



ICT and Audio-Visual Labs

Well- equipped computer laboratory is available for the students of all Grades. We use ICT facilities for teaching in various disciplines as well as for research works. The School has upgraded its ICT Lab, including SMART BOARDS to familiarize our students with the latest technologies and use them for effective instructional activities. We also have sufficient computers, and audio-visual equipment including VCD players, TV, projectors and sound boxes for learning through audio-visuals and for conducting various presentations, trainings and performing arts programs.



International Language

In a global context, we all are supposed to be global citizens, and learning a foreign language is a big step in becoming one of them. Besides English, we have also introduced Chinese language. Chinese language is very important for trade and tourism offering our future generation high prospects to benefit from the growing economy of China.



Libraries

KMC School has focused on developing students' reading habits and language skills making them go beyond the text books and explore the resources on the topics of their interest. The School's Library collection include English and Nepali Classics as well as Contemporary Children's Literature. It also contains the works of children as part of their curricular activities. Our library has a separate reading section, and a reference book section. For Junior Grades (Pre-school and Primary School) we have Book Corners in each class with interesting books that can offer them the joy of reading.

Visual and Performing Arts

Besides curricular activities, KMC School has also focused on developing students' hobbies in Visual and Performing Arts. We have a large Art Room with well-set resources, Music Rooms with varied musical equipment and instruments, and a Dance Studio with large mirrors where students can observe themselves improving their skills and performances on a daily basis.

Exhibitions and Fair

Exhibitions help children to plan, create, demonstrate and justify their work and most importantly make them more independent and confident in their own learning process. So, we organize several educational fairs every year. Besides this, we also hold intra-class, intra-school and inter-school exhibitions in diverse fields such as Arts and Craft, STEM (Science, Technology and Mathematics), Environment/Ecology, Language Arts, Culture, Fruits and Vegetables, etc.



ECA/CCA and Club Activities

ECA/CCA and Club activities are very important for students to expand their hobbies and enjoy the activities they like. Joining clubs and volunteering is a great way to:

- Change hobby to proficiency
- Make new friends
- Build respect and learn team work
- Gain self-confidence
- Relieve stress
- Learn real world and everyday life skills
- Develop time management skills
- Avoid risky behaviors

The school has hired professional coaches and luminaries in their respective fields to conduct various club activities. The clubs and Extra Curricular Activities which are functional at present are:

Basketball, Table Tennis, Chess, Music, Cricket, Athletics, Badminton, Football,

Swimming, Yoga, Environment, Science, Drawing & Painting, Craft Works, Cooking, Sewing, Drama, Dance, Singing, Music-Instrumental and Vocals, Aikido, Roller Skate and Languages. Similarly, some of our Co-curricular Activities are:

Hand Writing, Speech, Poem Writing, Poem Recitations, Slam Poetry, Story Writing, Story-Telling, Essay Writing, Visual Arts, Spelling Bee, Quizzes, Best Out of Waste, Off-the-Cuff, Drama, Newspaper Reading, Book Reading, etc.

Community Cleaning, Blood Donation, Rice Plantation, Scout Camps, Cooking Competition, etc. are also part of our school activities. We even conduct various intra-school and inter-school events and competitions to enhance learning through experiences, interactions and sharing.

Students' Quality Circle

Students' Quality Circle is an approach to make students work in a team, investigate the problems, analyze the problems, develop and apply action plans, and resolve the real-life problems by themselves. They learn to become responsible in their work and, at the same time they learn to use statistical tools for data analysis and communication skills. They gain confidence to express themselves in public and defend their points. They can also experience many national and international conferences and conventions which can be defining moments to understand the international context as well.





Science, Mathematics and Language Labs

KMC believes in learning through exploration and experiences. We have well-equipped Science Labs for Physics, Biology, Chemistry and Astrology so that students can learn through experiments. We also have Mathematics and Language Labs well-equipped with technology and hands on materials.

Continuous Assessment

We have adopted a Continuous Assessment System (CAS) to avoid the fear of examinations/ tests and support students for continuous learning. We assess our students continuously and consistently throughout the academic year based on the set objectives, teaching-learning activities and students' attainments. Each and every single activity performed by a student, both inside and outside the School, forms the basis for getting due recognition. Students are awarded grades for their performance in key areas such as Assignments, Participation, Group Works, Project/Creative Works, Mid-term/Unit Exams, Term Exams, etc. Hence, at KMC School, continuous assessment is given a significant weightage for the student's final evaluation.

We have adopted fully CAS and Portfolio based evaluation system in our Pre-school. Evaluation in Grades I to IX comprises 50% from CAS (classroom interactions, groupworks, project/creative works, assignments, and Mid-term/Unit Exams) and 50% from the Term Exams.



Parenting and Motivation

School offers parenting sessions for the parents and motivation workshops for students and teachers. The parenting sessions are focused on developing and practicing good parenting strategies and skills. The motivational workshops inspire students and teachers to focus in their goals.

In-House Training and Professional Development

We believe that teacher training plays a key role in improving the quality of teaching and learning activities which, in turn, gets transformed into the learning outcomes of the children. Hence, we have established a regular training and support system for the teachers. Education experts and subject specialists are working as a team with the teachers in improving their quality of classroom instruction, classroom management, materials development, student evaluation, behavior management, and developing KMC School as a safe and child-friendly school for the 21st Century. Our teachers have faith in the noble creation through their own efforts in their work places. This can be possible by mutual sharing of the best experiences and the best classroom practices among them. We also provide training and orientations for Admin and support staff to uplift their professionalism and quality of service.

Health Care & Safety

The school has a full-time nurse in position in school infirmary for immediate service in need. We provide First Aid on the spot in the case of any accidents or illness. Parents are contacted or notified and the child is taken to a nearby hospital immediately for further treatment, if necessary. We are highly aware of the safety of your child. In periodic basis we offer Dental Camps, Eye Camps and General health Check-up for students in our school.



Playgrounds

We have separate playgrounds for different school blocks so that the maximum number of children can play and enjoy outdoor activities. The play stations are made safe and child-friendly.

Counseling Unit

The school has a counseling unit with a professional counselor. She/he has earned her/his degree and training in psychology and counseling. The counselor takes care of psychological, behavioral and social problems of our children. The counselor also provides the service for children individually or in groups to deal with their personal and group issues.



Canteen

Our dedicated and hardworking canteen staff are busy round the clock preparing delicious, fresh and healthy food items for our students and staff. A wholesome, hot and fresh menu that ensures a balanced diet is provided to children and faculty who wish to have snacks and meals at our school. We encourage our students to enjoy fresh and healthy snacks served in our canteen.

Services



School Transport Service

The Transport Department manages the safe and smooth transport of our students to and from the school. Our drivers have been specially trained to respond to a variety of conditions that they may face on the road. Our bus attendants make sure that young children are never dropped off unless there is an adult to receive and pick them up. We frequently give orientations to the bus staff to reflect on their responsibilities and make them proficient in their jobs.



Security

The school is located within a secured compound. High walls and fencing mark the borders of the school, and the front gate is opened only after visitors are identified. Well trained, fully equipped, ex-army guards offer patrol service to the school around the clock.



Hostel

We have prepared our hostel settings and human resources keeping in mind hostel for our children must be “a home away from home”. We have separate dormitories for Girls, Junior Boys and Senior Boys. Not only we do believe in providing better accommodation, but also provide students with well-balanced diet and a homely care. We have capacity to accommodate 100 and plus students with required facilities. To ensure safety, all the hostel buildings lie within the school premises. Additionally, qualified wardens and instructors attend all the hostel life of the students including studies, health, diet, sanitation and cleanliness. We offer regular remedials/tutorials in the morning and evening to support their learning.

Admission Procedure

The school normally admits children of the appropriate age and ability and as per the seats available. Each academic session at KMC School comprises of twelve months starting in Baishakh (Mid – April) and ends the following Chaitra (Mid – March).

1. Age criteria: By Baishakh, a child should be of

the following ages for different levels:

- Play Group: 2-3 years,
- Nursery: 3-4 years,
- Preparatory: 4-5 years,
- Grade One: 5-6 years, and so on.

2. Those seeking admission should fill up and submit the admission form available at the School Administration or in the school website: www.kmcschool.edu.np

3. Children (Grade One and above) must sit for an entrance examination followed by interview.

4. Only the list of candidates, based on merit, will be published and recommended for admission, and their parents will be called for interview.

5. The Admission Committee takes the final decision based on the documents and interviews.

6. If the number of children seeking admission exceeds the number of seats available, the following criteria will be used to decide priority:

- Level of academic performance
- Local residents of the school area
- Having a brother or sister studying at the school
- Children from the deprived and underprivileged communities

7. Children who have been studying in any other school must submit the copies of the following documents during admission:

- Birth Certificate
- Progress Report and Mark Sheet of the Lower Grade than the applied one
- Transfer Certificate
- Awards, Honors, Prizes or Participation Certificates (if any)

8. Class Size: We strongly believe in nurturing young minds by providing individual care and attention. Our class sizes are “Small enough for individual care; big enough for efficiency”.

- Pre-primary School (PG to Prep II): 20 per class
- Primary School (Grade I to III): 25 per class
- Middle School (Grade IV to VI): 25 to 30 per class
- Senior School (Grade VII and above): 35 per class

Please Note: On all issues related to the Entrance Examination, Selection and Admission, the decision of the School Management is final.
