### Dear Parents,

It is amazing to see that end of the school year has arrived. I want to thank you all for all the support and patience shown in these past 11 months. We had successes and some challenges, yet despite all, we continued the work that has to be done. There are countless people to whom I owe my utmost gratitude and regards, and hope that we continue working together in the same way in coming days too.

This year 137 students of ours have appeared for SEE Board and we are hoping excellent results this year too. I would also like to express my thoughts to and about the departing Batch. This group of students is an extraordinary and eclectic group of young men and women, both collectively and individually. They are scholars, athletes, orators, engineers, musicians, mathematicians, comedians, and politicians. When I look at these students, I have hope for our future. I feel certain that their futures are bright. At the other end of the school, our Busy Preparatory children are ready for Grade I. They graduated from Pre-school amidst a function on 20<sup>th</sup> Baisakh. Graduation Day and Parents' Day of Pre-School was the last major programme of the academic session. The pre-school students under the supervision of teachers made the programme a huge success with wonderful and breathtaking performances.

### Curricular and Extra Curricular Activities

We believe motivational classes for the students are very much essential for their growth, development and reinforcement. For the same purpose, we organized "Positive Vibration" classes for the students from Grades VII – X from Mr. Pritam Poudyal. We will give continuity to such classes and even Parental Counselling in the coming session too. We have already completed handwriting classes for all the Grades. It has made remarkable change in handwriting of the students. These classes will get continuity in coming session too.

As part of EPH Project Work, students of Grade IX were divided into different groups and were assigned with field study of various organizations during winter vacation. During their visit, the students independently worked as a group without being accompanied by parents or teachers. They made detailed study of the organizations and made presentations in the class after the vacation.

ECA Activities for Term III began with **Christmas celebration**. Students of Middle School and Senior School

performed Christmas carols at morning assembly. There were Christmas Decorations and Celebrations at Pre and Primary School too. Students were distributed sweets. A student from Grade IV and a teacher from Pre-school enacted the roles of Santa Claus, and distributed sweets and gifts for the students. On 14<sup>th</sup> of Poush, students of grade VI were taken for one night and two days Scout Camp to Sundarjal. The students participated in various adventurous scouting activities like commando bridge, omega jump, etc. This year we had altogether three separate exhibitions. Middle and Senior School organized two separate Exhibitions on two different subject areas: exhibition on Language based subjects and another on Science, Mathematics and Computer. On 18<sup>th</sup> of Poush, we had **Language Arts and Social Sciences Exhibition**. Teachers from the departments related with these subjects coordinated along with the students to showcase the event. Cultural dresses, food items, folk dances of various ethnic groups, Home Made Pickles, items made from paper, language games, booklets, bookmark, etc. were exhibited during the exhibition.

On Friday, 5<sup>th</sup> of Magh, we organized **Science, Mathematics and Computer Exhibition**. Solid shapes, experiments, puzzles, games, thread art designs, hydraulics, subject related information, photo booth, etc. were the centre of attraction. **Annual Sports Week** began on Sunday, 7<sup>th</sup> of Magh and ended with Grand celebrations and Prize Distribution on Friday, 12<sup>th</sup> of Magh at Army Sports Complex, Lagankhel. Students from Pre School to Grade IX had taken part in various athletic events, minor and major games as well. Students had competed for 416 gold, 356 silver and 356 bronze medals. In total, 1128 medals were distributed to the students. Annual Sports Day was conducted at Army Sports Complex, Lagankhel. Baikunthanath Manandhar, legendary Marathon Runner and gold Medalist in three consecutive SAFF Games, was the Chief Guest for the Ceremony. In March Past, Phewa House was adjusted first whereas in drill, Rara House took the first position. The prestigious House of the Year Award went to Phewa House for accumulating maximum points from entire ECA Activities. The students performed march-past, drills, aerobics, martial arts, and competed in athletic events and football matches. The winners were given certificates and medals by Chief Guest of the programme. On Monday, 8<sup>th</sup> of Magh, we had **Grand Saraswati Puja Celebration** at the school premises. **Aakshararambha** was done for the students who joined Play Group.

On 19<sup>th</sup> of Magh, students of Grade VII were taken for two nights and three days **Scout Camp at International Scouts Training Center, Kakani**. The students were involved in different scouting activities like rock climbing, omega jump, abseiling, etc. throughout the camp. On 20<sup>th</sup> of Magh, students of Grade X were taken on two nights and three days **tour of Pokhara-Ghandruk**. On 26<sup>th</sup> of Magh, Pre and Primary School organize Exhibition on various themes and subjects. On 27<sup>th</sup> of Magh, students of Grade VIII were taken on **One Night/Two days Hike to Chitlang and Kulekhani**.

On Friday, 5<sup>th</sup> of Falgun, **Senior School Parents' Day was celebrated** in a grand way at the school premises. Directors, Academic Advisor and Principal gave away awards to students on different categories. The students showcased their talents and skills through dances, music, drama, anchoring and fashion show. On the same day, **KMC School Art Exhibition** was organised at School Hall.

Department of English organized **Word Warrior Slam Poetry**. From Grade VI and VII category, Kohinoor Kamchha of Grade VI 'AP', Bandana Gyawali VI 'MP', Eva Bhattarai VI 'MP' and Avignya Gautam of Grade VII 'GS' secured first, second, third and consolation positions, respectively. From Grade VIII, Aditya Napit, Resha Acharya, Sailee Singh Maharjan and Bhumika Khadka secured first, second, third and consolation positions, respectively. In Grade IX category, Shubhechha Vaidya, Shruti Dahal and Aayusha Karki of IX 'AP' secured First, Second and Third, and Priyasha Puri of Grade IX 'GS' secured consolation positions.

On 23<sup>rd</sup> of Falgun, **KMC Dancing Star Season-IV** was organized at school premises. From the audition, 12 students were selected and went through rigorous trainings under different Choreographers. In senior category, Princess Koirala of Grade IX was adjusted the winner. Bigina Maharjan and Suprim Banjara of same Grades were 1<sup>st</sup> Runner Up and 2<sup>nd</sup> Runner Up. In Junior category, Sanskriti Pandey of Grade IV was declared the winner. Bhugol Khadka of Grade IV and Ebosna Thapa of Grade I were adjusted 1<sup>st</sup> Runner Up and 2<sup>nd</sup> Runner Up. The winners and participants were awarded by Chief Guest of the programme Damodar Neupane, a book writer and senior journalist from Kantipur National Daily. Kala Rai, social activist and Sajan Tamang, Winner of Chhamchhami Season II were the Special Guests. On 26<sup>th</sup> of Falgun, **Inter-patrol Scout Cooking Competition** was held at the School Premises.
