4. Teaching-learning at KMC is student-centered, focusing on hands-on activities for learning through experiences and guide them to construct their own understanding. The instructional activities also engage students up to critical and creative thinking.
5. School is a place that provides foundation for "lifelong learning", which is possible only if teachers and students work together in respectful, noble, and caring atmosphere. Students need to have freedom to express their feelings and share their creativities.

Curriculum

Our curriculum strives to nurture each child's intellectual, social, emotional, physical and spiritual development. The core of our curriculum is guided by the national curriculum framework. However, we have enriched our curriculum sufficiently with contents for addressing children's special interests and needs, and preparing them for the world class citizen of the twenty first century.

We have developed the Pre-school curriculum based on their ability to learn and cognitive level. Accordingly, the curriculum has been developed combining the essence of Montessori / ECD approaches and including the various skills such as social soft skills, language and communication skills, and mathematics and science connecting the students to their everyday life. The Pre-school curriculum also includes visual and performing arts to teach them to live a vibrant and joyful life. Thus, our curriculum is multifaceted in the true sense.

Curriculum at the Junior Primary Level (grade 1 to 3) is based on the government curriculum. However, we have enriched the curriculum with additional skills in the areas of language

and life skills. At this level we have included international languages and the basics of performing and visual arts too. Curriculum at this level is designed for integrated approach so that the children could learn to connect their knowledge with different disciplines.

Curricula at the Senior Primary Level (Grade 4 to 8) and at the Secondary Level are complemented by additional skills in languages and arts. At these levels, students are expected to master the skills in performing/visual arts/games through clubs. Specifically, the Senior Primary curriculum is designed to prepare students for secondary school on the basis of their interest and abilities.

The School fully relies on the Government Curriculum for its Secondary Level. However, the school has included supplementary curriculum for language development. Students are given opportunities to develop their hobbies through clubs and various curricular and co-curricular activities.



Student - Centered Teaching Learning

We make sure that whatever practice we do puts the child's learning in focus. We design activities in such a way that the children are provided ample opportunities to lead their teams, learn to value the other viewpoints and opinions, generate knowledge on the strength of their teams and prove their achievements through collaborative, co-operative, project-based and activities-based teaching-learning approaches.

Research and Innovations

We make children independent and self-sustaining to deal with the challenges of this century through research, innovations and problem solving in real life. These activities give our students ample opportunities to work in harmony with their community and contribute to its betterment. School is adopting micro-level researches as curricular and co-curricular activities for testing hypothesis, exploring the subjects, and understanding nature and the communities. The activities are also expected to focus on resolving problems and innovations. KMC also guides and inspires students for connecting their learning to innovations and creations that ultimately foster students' aptitude to transform their learning for life through these research activities.

Excursion and Educational Tours

We organize regular excursions, field trips and educational tours for intensive learning as per the demand of the contents. Students are guided to observe, explore, investigate, analyze and share their experiences through reports and presentations. This indeed testifies to the essence of the KMC's philosophy of learning through real life experience.



Exhibitions and Fair

Exhibitions help children to plan, create, demonstrate and justify their work and most importantly make them more independent and confident in their own learning process. KMC School organizes a grand exhibition once a year. Besides this, we also hold intra – class, intra – school and inter – school exhibitions in diverse fields such as Arts and craft, Maths, Science and Technology, Environment/Ecology, Literature, etc. School also organizes various exhibitions and fairs such as food fair, art and craft exhibition to promote the social well-being.



International Languages

In a global context, we all are supposed to be global citizens, and learning a foreign language is a big step in becoming a global citizen. Besides English, we are also introducing Chinese and French language in order to understand many people and places of the world. Chinese language is very important for trade and tourism, offering our future generation high prospect to benefit from the growing economy of China. Similarly, French is the second most popular language in Europe.



Continuous Assessment

We have adopted Continuous Assessment System (CAS) to avoid fear of examinations or tests and support students for continuous learning. We assess our students continuously and consistently throughout the academic year based on the set objectives, teaching-learning activities and students' attainments. Each and every single activity performed by a student, both inside and outside the School, forms the basis for getting due recognition. Students are awarded grades for their performance in key areas such as regularity, home and class assignment, interactions, participation, quizzes, presentations, discipline, punctuality, creations etc. Hence, at KMC, continuous assessment is given a significant weightage for the student's final evaluation.



ICT and Audio-Visual Lab

A well- equipped computer laboratory is available for the students of all grades. KMC School uses its ICT facilities for teaching in various disciplines as well as for research work. The School has upgraded its ITC lab including the SMART BOARDS to familiarize our students with the latest technologies and use them for effective instructional activities. We also have sufficient computers, and audio-visual equipments, including VCD players, TV, projectors and sound boxes for learning through audio-visuals and for conducting various presentations, trainings and performing arts programs.



KMC believes in learning through exploration and experiences. We have well-equipped Science labs for Physics, Biology, Chemistry and Astrology so that students can learn through experiments.



Art Rooms

Besides curricular activities, KMC School has also focused on developing students' hobbies in visual and performing arts. We have a large Art Room with well-set resources, a Music Room with varied musical equipment and instruments, and a Dance Studio with large mirrors where students can observe themselves improving their skills and performances on a daily basis.



Libraries

KMC School has focused on developing students' reading habits and language skills, and making them go beyond the text books and explore the resources on the topics of their interest. The School's Library collections include English and Nepali classics as well as contemporary children's literature. It also contains the works by children as part of their curricular activities. Our library has a separate reading section, a reference book section, and an audio visual language lab.

For junior classes we have Book Corners in each class with interesting books for little children.





Club Activities

Club activities are very important for students to expand their hobbies and enjoy the activities they like. Joining clubs and volunteering is a great way to:

- ✓ Build respect and learn team work,
- ✓ Gain self-confidence,
- ✓ Relieve stress,
- ✓ Learn real world and everyday life skills,
- ✓ Develop time management skills and
- ✓ Avoid risky behaviors

The School has hired professional coaches and celebrities in their respective fields to conduct various club activities. The clubs which are functional at present are:

Basketball, Table Tennis, Chess, Music, Cricket, Athletics, Badminton, Football, Swimming, Yoga, Environment, Science ("Team Innovation"), Drawing & Painting, Craft works, Cooking, Sewing, Drama, Dance, Singing, Music-Instrumental and Vocals, and Languages.

Our Extra-curricular Activity Coordinator is fully aware of the need and interest of our children in the ever changing times through efficient management of these clubs. New clubs will be launched as per the need and interest of the students and availability of the resources.



Students' Quality Circle

Students' Quality Circle is an approach to make students work in team, investigate the problems, analyze the problems, develop and apply action plans, and resolve the real life problems by themselves. They learn to become responsible in their work and, at the same time learn to use statistical tools for data analysis and communication skills. They gain confidence to express themselves in public and defend their points. They can also experience by participating in many national and international conferences and conventions which will be their important moments to learn the international context as well.





In-House Training and Professional Development

We believe that teacher training plays a key role in improving the quality of teaching and learning activities which, in turn, gets transformed into the learning outcomes of the children. Hence, we have established a regular training and support system for the teachers. Education experts and subject specialists are working as a team with the teachers in improving their quality of classroom instruction, classroom management, materials development, student evaluation, behavior management, and developing KMC as a safe and child-friendly school for the 21st Century. Our teachers have faith in the novel creation through their own efforts in their work places. This is made possible by mutual sharing of best experiences and the best classroom practices among them. We also provide training and orientations for support staff to uplift their professionalism.



Dedicated Faculty

KMC's faculty of highly trained, experienced, caring and extremely motivated in the art of teaching and learning. There are continuous in-service training sessions for teachers, who are expected to keep abreast of the latest innovations and best practices in education.

We have Level In-charges and Heads of Departments to monitor and support instructional activities, and sustain the continuous growth of our institution.



Class Size

We strongly believe in nurturing young minds by providing individual care and attention. This is truly reflected in our policy of class sizes which is "Small enough for individual care; big enough for efficiency". The class sizes are as follows:

Pre-primary: 20 per class

Junior Primary (Grade I to III): 25 per class

Senior Primary (Grade IV to VI): 25 to 30 per class

Senior School (Grade VII and above): 35 per class

Additional Services

Counseling Unit

School has a counseling unit with a professional counselor. She/he has earned her/his degree and training in psychology and counseling. The counselor takes care of psychological, behavioral and social problems of the children. The counselor also provides the service for children individually or in groups to deal with their personal and group issues.



Halls and Playgrounds

We have spacious multi-purpose halls for conducting programs, workshops, meditations, and indoor sport activities. We also have separate playgrounds for different school blocks so that the maximum number of children can play and enjoy the out-door activities, both curricular and extra-curricular activities.





Health Care & Safety

School has a full time Nurse in position in school infirmary for immediate service in need. In the case of accidents or illness concerning any child, we provide First Aid on the spot. Parents will be contacted or notified and the child will be taken to a nearby hospital immediately for further treatment, if necessary. We are highly aware of the safety of your child. Whether children are in or out of School, we are well prepared to respond to a variety of emergency situations.



Canteen

Our dedicated and hardworking canteen staff are busy round the clock preparing delicious, fresh and healthy food items for our students and staff. A wholesome, hot and fresh menu that ensures a balanced diet is provided to children and faculty who wish to have snacks and meals at school. We encourage our students to enjoy fresh and healthy snacks served at our canteen.

School Hostel

We have prepared our hostel settings and human resources keeping in mind hostel for our children must be "a home away from home".

We have separate Junior and Senior hostels for boys and girls. Our hostel team is prepared to work day and night tirelessly in order to provide the highest degree of care and emotional support to our children. Our hostel children can enjoy modern hostel facilities and homely environment at a reasonable cost. Our hostel is much liked by our residential students. We offer every support needed for the children to ensure they are physically healthy and strong, and academically sound. We have outstanding team of teachers to guide them on regular basis to uplift their learning gain. They also have regular meditation, and sporting activities to help them to become healthy and calm.



Security

The school is located within a secure compound. High walls and fencing mark the borders of the school, and the front gate is opened only after visitors are identified. Well trained, fully equipped, Ex-Army guards offer patrol service to the school round the clock.



School Transport Service

The Transport Department manages the safe and smooth transport of our students to and from the School. Our buses are in excellent condition for easy communication with the School in the event of emergency. Our drivers have been specially trained to respond to a variety of conditions that they may face on the road. Our bus attendants make sure that young children are never dropped off unless there is an adult to receive and pick them up. We frequently give orientations to the bus staff to reflect on their responsibilities and make them proficient in their jobs.

Admission Procedure

The school normally admits children of the appropriate age and ability and as per the seats available. Each academic session at KMC School comprises twelve months starting in Baishakh (Mid - April) and ends the following Chaitra (Mid - March).

1. Age criteria : By Baishakh, a child should be of the following age for different levels:
 - ✓ 2-3years in Play Group
 - ✓ 3-4years in Nursery
 - ✓ 4-5 years in Preparatory
 - ✓ 5-6years in Grade One and so on.
2. Those seeking admission should fill up and submit the admission form available at the School Administration or in the school website www.kmcschool.edu.np.
3. Children must sit for an entrance examination conducted by the Student Admission Committee.
4. Only the list of candidates, based on merit, will be published and recommended for admission. Selected children and their parents will be called for interview.

5. The admission committee takes the final decision after checking the documents and interviewing the child and his/her parents.
6. Children who have been studying in any other school must submit the copies of the following documents during admission:
 - ✓ Progress report and mark sheet of the previous year
 - ✓ Transfer Certificate
 - ✓ Awards, Honors, Prizes or Participation Certificates (If any)
 - ✓ Birth Certificate
7. Based on the written entrance examination, interview and other criteria, the School reserves the right to admit students. If the number of children seeking admission exceeds the number of seats available, the following criteria will be used to decide priority:
 - ✓ Level of academic performance
 - ✓ Local residents of Buddhanagar area
 - ✓ Having a brother or sister studying at the School
 - ✓ Children from the deprived and underprivileged communities

*On all issues related to the entrance examination, selection and admission, the decision of the School Management is final.
